Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Matches will be conducted as per the rules and regulations of the BCCI (Board of Control for Cricket in India). However, certain rules may be modified to suit local requirements and circumstances.
2. All matches will be played on a league basis in the T-20 format.
3. Each team shall consist of 16 members, including the wicketkeeper.
4. Matches will be played with red balls. Players must wear their respective House T-shirts along with white track pants in both Junior and Senior categories.
5. Each match shall consist of 15 overs per innings for the Senior category and 10 overs per innings for the Junior category.
6. The winning team shall be awarded 2 points, while the losing team shall receive no points.
7. In case of a tie, both teams shall be awarded 1 point each.
8. If a match cannot be completed due to unavoidable circumstances, the run rate of the first 10 overs will be considered. The team with the higher run rate will be declared the winner.

9. If the team batting second has not completed 10 overs and play is stopped due to unavoidable circumstances, the match will be considered cancelled and shall be replayed.
10. After completion of the league matches, the team securing the highest number of points will be declared the winner of the tournament. Other teams will be ranked accordingly based on their total points.
11. In case two teams finish with an equal number of points, the overall run rate from all their matches will be considered. The team with the higher run rate will be declared the winner.
12. If two teams still have the same run rate, the result of their head-to-head match in the league stage will decide the winner.
13. House Masters and team captains will be held responsible for maintaining discipline. Any act of misbehavior or use of indecent remarks against umpires, players, or any other participants will invite strict disciplinary action.
14. The Captain must submit the list of 12 players (including the 12th man) to the umpire before the toss. No changes to this list shall be permitted thereafter.
15. Each bowler may bowl a maximum of 3 overs in the senior category and a maximum of 2 overs in the junior category.
16. The decision of the umpire(s) shall be final and binding on all teams.
