Inter-house Competitions: A Year of Distinction

St. Andrew's House displayed exceptional skill, determination, and sportsmanship across a wide range of competitions, securing podium finishes in numerous events.

In Football, consistent teamwork enabled the House to secure the overall Runner-up position.

In Swimming, outstanding performances by Stavya Agarwal, Aarav Varshney, Arnav Tiwari, and Vihaan Pant ensured a clean sweep of top positions, helping the House emerge as the overall champions.

In Table Tennis, commendable performances by Shikhar Awasthi, Siddharth Agarwal, and S. M. Khubaib Noori earned the House the Runner-up position.

The House also secured the Runner-up position in the Group Singing Competition.

In Kabaddi, the leadership of Adduaye Yadav, supported by Shayan Zia, Krishna Yadav, Abhishek, and Nilesh Singh, guided the House to the championship title.

Exceptional teamwork by Adduaye Yadav, Sanskar Saxena, Unnayan Shukla, and S. M. Khubaib Noori enabled the House to secure the First position in Basketball.

The House dominated the Chess Competition, finishing First overall, while the Cricket Team, led by Ansh Kumar Singh and ably supported by Adduaye Yadav, Siddharth Agarwal, Krishnum Pandey, Shlok Trivedi, and Taresh Kumar, also secured the championship title.

Our athletes delivered remarkable performances at the 41st Post-Centenary Annual Athletic Meet, reflecting dedication, discipline, and perseverance.

S. M. Khubaib Noori won Gold Medals in both the Javelin Throw and Discus Throw, bringing his total tally to eleven

Gold Medals. He also represented the School at the Zonal and Regional Competitions.

Adduaye Yadav secured the First position in the High Jump, Second positions in the Triple Jump and Hurdles, finished Sixth in the Cross-Country Race, and anchored the relay team to a Third-place finish.

Ansh Kumar Singh secured the Runner-up position in both the Shot Put and Javelin Throw, while Krishna Yadav finished Second in the Discus Throw and Third in the Shot Put. Shourya Dwivedi also represented the House with distinction.

Shayan Zia won the Gold Medal in the 100-metre Sprint and secured the Runner-up position in the Relay Race. Pranjal Singh claimed the Gold Medal in the 5-kilometre Walk, while Siddharth Agarwal secured the First position in the Slow Cycle Race, supported by Abhishek, Rishabh, and Mohd. Abbas. Akshat Vardhan Singh also secured the First position in the 100-metre Sprint.
